Psychologist

WJCS is looking for a psychologist for the Trager Lemp Center (TLC) for Trauma and Resilience program located in Hartsdale, NY, 21-35 hours per week. This position includes benefits.

The psychologist provides:

- Supervision for clinical staff, psychology interns, externs, and other trainees, provides programmatic guidance and provides direct service using evidence-based trauma practices, including intakes, ongoing cases, and managing clinical crises.
- Oversees research projects and is expected to provide trainings for the TLC team and the Educational Institute.
- Leadership in the administration of appropriate assessment measures for children and their families, in coordination with staff members who track and maintain the databases. Participation in staff consultations and conferences.

Work is performed as a member of a multi-disciplinary team composed of psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers and case managers who are responsible for the diagnosis and treatment of patients. The psychologist is an integrated member of the psychology department at WJCS and will actively participate in the WJCS APA-accredited internship selection and training process. The selected individual must have a thorough understanding of trauma across the lifespan. The psychologist must have experience working on an interdisciplinary team in an outpatient setting, a commitment to evidence-based practices, research skills, and a comfort with Electronic Health Records.

The Trauma team is a strongly supportive and multidisciplinary group, so the desire to be part of a team coupled with the ability to be a team player is essential. We strive to be anti-racist, with focus and emphasis on understanding structural racism and its impact on the families we serve, and ourselves.

The selected candidate must have a doctorate from an APA-accredited Psychology program in clinical, counseling, or school psychology, have completed an APA-accredited internship, and possess a valid New York State license.
